Report of the Chairman: Mr. Montanari reported that the rubber surface needed under the work-out stations at Kotecki Park will be finished by the Eagle Scout.

Report of Council Representative

Councilwoman Albanese reported that an Eagle Scout attended a Council meeting earlier in the year, to discuss installing fishing line catchers at Burrell Lake Park as part of his Eagle Scout project. Council voted to allow the project to proceed. New playground equipment acquired through efforts of City Administrator Rockwell has been installed at Veterans Park. New basketball nets will be ordered and resurfacing the basketball court will be a consideration in the 2021 budget.
